 The Town Clerk reported that the Board is in situ at Carreg yr Halen. The App is not yet available and will be posted on the website when launched.

 11. Ash dieback disease
 The Town Clerk reported that the above disease has been identified on trees on Town Council land. The Town Council’s workman will be monitoring the diseased trees and keeping a record on a plan provided.

 The Town Clerk reported 15 footpaths in Menai Bridge most of them being on Town Council land.
